**District Shirt Colors:**

White ,Gray, and Navy Blue

Any Lamar County Student may wear the District colors.

**Individual School Shirt Colors:**

Baxterville Navy Blue and Red

Oak Grove\* Black and Gold

Purvis Purple and Gold

Sumrall Blue and Gold

**Pants Colors:**

Khaki\*\*, Black and Navy Blue

\* Students may NOT wear black on black or blue on black (i.e. black shirt and black pants, blue shirt and black skirt/shorts)

\*\*Khaki is defined as light or dark tan in color.

**LOGOS**

Brand logos - One only and must be small enough to be covered by a quarter.

School logos - Must be on front left chest no larger than 4" in diameter.

**Reward Days**

At school principal's discretion, jeans and t-shirts may be allowed as a reward or used for special days.  
Jeans must be denim and a shade of blue with no extra pockets (standard 4 pocket).  
T-shirts must be of a district or school color.  
They must be crew neck, short or long sleeved.

**Picture Days**

On school picture days all rules apply except for colors. Student may wear any color combination. If a student is absent on school picture day, they may bring alternate clothing to change into for make-up pictures.

**Elementary School Allowances**

The following list of exemptions and changes apply to children in grades Kindergarten through fifth grade only:

- Denim jeans in shades of blue only
- Hooded shirts are allowed (must be removed indoors)
- Shirts may be untucked as long as they do not exceed wrist length
- Tennis shoes **must** be worn at PE

## TOPS

Collared shirt/Turtleneck with or without pockets, short or long sleeves. Shirts must be of the type material so that undergarments are not visible or an undershirt is required. *Shirts must be a solid color and tucked in at all times*

Undershirts undershirt must be crew neck and white or of color that matches outer shirt.

## BOTTOMS (NO DENIM)

Khaki, Black, or Navy Blue

Boys: Pants or shorts

Girls: Pants, skirts, Capri's, shorts, skorts, jumpers or dresses

## OUTER WEAR

- No hoodies allowed (i.e. pullover with hood).
- Must be worn as designed not tied at the waist
- Must be unzipped/unbuttoned when indoors
- School activity jackets are allowed (i.e. letterman, band, cheer, etc.)

## COATS/JACKETS

- No color/logo restrictions
- Must not exceed the fingertips in length
- Must be removed while in classroom

## SWEATERS/VESTS/ SWEATSHIRTS

Black, Brown, Navy, Tan, White or School Color Only.

- School logos are acceptable but must meet logo guidelines.
- Must be waist high.
- A collared shirt/turtleneck must be worn underneath in order for students to remove the outer wear.

## SHOES

(Tennis shoes are allowed.)

Black, Brown, Navy, Tan or Gray

- Shoes may be solid white or white with any combination of the approved color (Shoe color does not apply to elementary students k-5)
- Laces must be solid in a shoe color and tied at all times. (Lace color does not apply to elementary students k-5)

## SOCKS/HOSE/TIGHTS

Black, Brown, Navy, Tan, Gray or White

- Must be solid in color.

## ITEMS NOT ALLOWED

NO hoodies, sweatpants, wind pants, velour, overalls, skater pants or carpenter pants. Belt loops must not be removed. Pants may not be rolled up unless cuffed. Pant length may not exceed the bottom of the shoe. No pure elastic waist pants (does not apply to elementary students k-5). No drawstrings at waist or pants leg. Appliqués/designs are not allowed on any clothing. No cuts or tears are allowed in clothing. No visible price tags. Denim fabric is not allowed for any clothing except jackets/coats/vests.

## Additional Information

Pockets: No pockets on pants, skirts, shorts except those made into the side seams of the garment, with the exception of back pockets. No extra pockets.

Accessories: Hair accessories must match dress color. Jewelry should be unobtrusive. Winter hats, scarves and gloves may be black, brown, navy, tan, or gray.

Pants: Must be secured at the WAIST with a belt. No denim material.

Belts: Must be plain black or brown

Tops: All shirts must be tucked in completely. Skin may not show at waist. See policy regarding undershirts.

Length: Shorts not to exceed 5" above the top of the knee. All other apparel will be no more than 4" above the top of the knee.

Outerwear: This includes heavier coats for colder weather. Lining color is not an issue.

Transfers: Students who transfer from other districts will be given five (5) days to comply.
