The report must contain information about the professional qualifications of teachers in core academic subject areas (English, reading, language arts, science, mathematics, foreign languages, arts, civics and government, economics, history, and geography). Highly qualified teachers are those who satisfied the NCLB criteria during the school year. The report must also contain achievement data for specific subgroups, two-year achievement trends, and student participation rates.
